CONTRACT AMENDMENT 2**

CONTRACT #NORTH SOUND BH-ASO-MOUNT BAKER PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH ICN-23

Based on the Agreement of the parties to the above-referenced Contract between the North Sound Behavioral Health Administrative Services Organization, LLC (North Sound BH-ASO) and Mount Baker Presbyterian Church (Contractor) dated November 15, 2023 (as amended by North Sound BH-ASO and Provider dated October 29, 2024), is hereby amended as follows:

The purpose of this amendment is to add/remove/replace definitions and to provide funding for Opioid Outreach for July 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025.

By mutual agreement of the parties, the following language is added to the agreement:

- **Add the following new definitions to *Article 1 – Definitions*:**

“Behavioral Health Service Provider” means a public or private agency that provides mental health, substance use disorder, or co-occurring disorder services to persons with Behavioral Health disorders as defined under this section and receives funding from public sources. This includes, but is not limited to hospitals licensed under chapter 70.41 RCW; Evaluation and Treatment Facilities; community mental health service delivery systems or community Behavioral Health programs as defined in RCW 71.24.025; licensed or certified Behavioral Health agencies under RCW 71.24.037; an entity with a Tribal attestation that it meets minimum standards or a licensed or certified Behavioral Health agency as defined in RCW 71.24.025; facilities conducting competency evaluations and restoration under chapter 10.77 RCW; approved substance use disorder treatment programs as defined in this section; Secure Withdrawal Management and Stabilization Facilities as defined in this section; and correctional facilities operated by state, local, and Tribal governments.

“Mental Health Care Provider” means an individual working in a Behavioral Health Agency, under the supervision of a Mental Health Professional, who has primary responsibility for implementing an individualized plan for mental health rehabilitation services. To provide services as a Mental Health Care Provider, this person must be a registered agency affiliated counselor and have a minimum of one year education or experience in mental health or related fields.

“Certified Peer Specialist (CPS)” means a person who meets the certification requirements as set forth in RCW 18.420.050 and is certified under chapter 18.420 RCW to engage in the practice of Peer Support Services.

“Certified Peer Specialist Trainee (CPST)” means a person who meets the certification requirements as set forth in RCW 18.420.060 and is working toward

the supervised experience requirements to become a Certified Peer Specialist under chapter 18.420 RCW.

“Substance Use Prevention, Treatment, and Recovery Services (SUPTRS)” means the federal Substance Use Prevention, Treatment, and Recovery Services block grant program authorized by Section 1921 of Title XIX, Part B, Subpart II and III of the Public Health Service Act.

- **Remove 1.26 Substance Abuse Block Grant (SABG)**, which reads SABG means the Federal Substance Abuse Block Grant Program authorized by Section 1921 of Title XIX, Part B, Subpart II and III of the Public Health Service Act.
- **Replace 1.5 Certified Counselor**, which reads “Certified Peer Counselor (CPC) means Individuals who: have self-identified as a consumer of behavioral health services; have received specialized training provided/contracted by HCA’s, Division of Behavioral Health and Recovery (DBHR); have passed a written/oral test, which includes both written and oral components of the training; have passed a Washington State background check; have been certified by DBHR; and are a registered Agency Affiliated Counselor with the Department of Health (DOH).” **with the following:**

Certified Peer Counselor (CPC) means a person who meets certification requirements as set forth in WAC 182-115-0200 to engage in the practice of Peer Support Services until December 31, 2025.
- **Replace 1.8 Culturally Appropriate Care**, which reads “Culturally Appropriate Care means health care services provided with Cultural Humility and an understanding of the patient’s culture and community, and informed by Historical Trauma and the resulting cycle of Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs).” **with the following:**

“Culturally Appropriate Care” means the practice of being sensitive to a person’s cultural identity or heritage. Health care services are provided with Cultural Humility and an understanding of the patient’s culture and community and informed by Historical Trauma and the resulting cycle of Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs).
- **Replace 7.17 Insurance**, which reads “North Sound BH-ASO certifies it is a member of Washington Governmental Risk Pool for all exposure to tort liability, general liability, property damage liability and vehicle liability, if applicable, as provided by RCW 43.19. By the date of execution of this Contract and post 15 days renewal of said contract, the Provider shall procure and maintain insurance for the duration of this Contract, Provider shall carry Commercial General Liability (CGL) Insurance to include coverage for bodily injury, property damage, and contractual liability, with the following minimum limits: Each Occurrence - \$1,000,000; General Aggregate - \$3,000,000; shall include liability arising out of premises, operations, independent contractors, personal injury, advertising injury, and liability assumed under an insured contract. The costs of such insurance shall be paid by the Provider or subcontractor. The Provider may furnish separate certificates of insurance and policy endorsements for each subcontractor as evidence of compliance with the insurance requirements of this Contract. The Provider is responsible for ensuring compliance with all of the insurance requirements stated herein. Failure by the Provider,

its agents, employees, officers, subcontractors, providers, and/or provider subcontractors to comply with the insurance requirements stated herein shall constitute a material breach of this Contract. All non-risk pool policies shall name North Sound BH-ASO as a covered entity under said policy(s).” **with the following:**

North Sound BH-ASO certifies it is a member of Washington Governmental Risk Pool for all exposure to tort liability, general liability, property damage liability and vehicle liability, if applicable, as provided by RCW 43.19. By the date of execution of this Contract and post 15 days renewal of said contract, the Provider shall procure and maintain insurance for the duration of this Contract, Provider shall carry Commercial General Liability (CGL) Insurance to include coverage for bodily injury, property damage, and contractual liability, with the following minimum limits: Each Occurrence - **\$2,000,000**; General Aggregate - **\$4,000,000**; shall include liability arising out of premises, operations, independent contractors, personal injury, advertising injury, and liability assumed under an insured contract. The costs of such insurance shall be paid by the Provider or subcontractor. The Provider may furnish separate certificates of insurance and policy endorsements for each subcontractor as evidence of compliance with the insurance requirements of this Contract. The Provider is responsible for ensuring compliance with all of the insurance requirements stated herein. Failure by the Provider, its agents, employees, officers, subcontractors, providers, and/or provider subcontractors to comply with the insurance requirements stated herein shall constitute a material breach of this Contract. All non-risk pool policies shall name North Sound BH-ASO as a covered entity under said policy(s).”

- **Replace** with *Exhibit E(a) – MBPC ICN Budget* with *Exhibit E(b) – MBPC ICN Budget*
- **Replace** *Exhibit F(a) – Federal Subaward Identification* with *Exhibit F(b) – Federal Subaward Identification*

ALL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
