SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES ADMINISTRATION (SAMSA) XYLAZINE ALERT

Please see the attached SAMHSA bulletin regarding the risks of xylazine which is a non-opioid veterinary anesthetic agent increasingly being found in combination with opioids such as fentanyl. Reports from SUD providers across the State indicate that this agent is being seen with an increasing frequency among individuals presenting for services.
